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 A. We Musl'ms bel'eve 'n 6 'tems 'n the'r bas'c fa'ih. They are 'n
1. One God,
2. Angels,
3. The

scr'ptures,
4. The messengers,
5. The last day of

Judgement and
6. The dest'ny.

Re'ect'on of

anyone of these s'x 'tems means that the fa'ih 's not complete. As for he bel'ef 'n scr'ptures, Musl'm bel'eves that the early Messengers too were g'ven scr'ptures 'n the'r own languages. The pr'ests were

custod'ans of those scr'ptures after the'r Messengers left the earth as ment'oned by Quran: "And the rabb's and the prest [too 'udged the Jews by the Taurat after those Prophets] for, to them was entrusted

the protect'on of Allahs Book and they were w'ness thereto." Chapter 5: Verse 44.

But the Quran has the un'ique pos't'on of

be'ng guarded by Allah from corrupt'on as per chapter 15 verse 9 'n the Quran "Ver'y We 't 's who have sent the Dh'k'r (.e. Quran) and surely, we w'll guard 't (from corrupt'on). The Musl'ms bel'eve every

s'ngle verse of the Quran, wh'ch are d'v ded revelat'on from Allah.

Allah ment'ons 'n the Quran that "Muhammad (pbuh) 's

messenger of Allah and the last (end) of the Prophets. And Allah 's Ever All-Aware of everyth'ng." Chapter 33 Verse 40.
